### AMENDMENT TO RNZYS SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### Amendment 1

The start of the race is outlined in the RNZYS Sailing Instructions, available on either the RNZYS or CYA websites.

For classic yachts, the courses listed in the RNZYS Handbook are amended as follows:

#### Course 1

Start – passing north of Motuihe Island – passing north of Waiheke Island – Gannet Rock (P) – to finish line (approx. 26 nm)

Finish line is a line extending south (magnetic) from the point east of Waiti Bay ( $36^{\circ}46.7'S$   $175^{\circ}11.6'E$ ) at the northern entrance to the Waiheke Channel

#### Course 2

Start – passing north of Browns Island – south of Waiheke Island – to finish line (approx. 23 nm)

Finish line is a line between Frenchmans Cap ( $36^{\circ}48.2'S$   $175^{\circ}11'E$ ) and Taniwhanui Point ( $36^{\circ}48.3'S$   $175^{\circ}10'E$ ) in the Waiheke Channel

**Finishers shall take their own times, and send a text message or email to the CYA Yacht Captain on 021 532 500, or [yachtcaptain@classicyacht.org.nz](mailto:yachtcaptain@classicyacht.org.nz)  
No committee boat will be present at the finish.**

Skippers are to note clause 8.2 of the RNZYS Sailing Instructions

**No later than the warning signal, the race committee boat, Westhaven or Orakei Tower will display the number of the course to be sailed.**
