Compulsory wearing of personal floatation devices is currently under discussion in our region.

Waikato Regional Council already enforces having a correctly sized PFD for each person on board. In vessels less than 6m, everyone must wear a lifejacket. Waikato Regional Council also state that PFD's must be worn if there are high risks to people's safety.

The Safety of the Captain and Crew of Vessels is imperative. The CYA recommends that lifejackets are worn whilst cruising and racing especially when the weather is not ideal and/or there is a lot of other boat traffic about.
