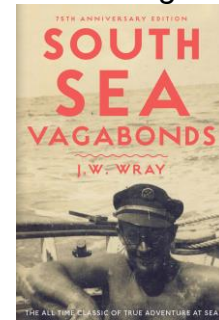


Ngataki, 1931 built by Johnny Wray
