Labour Weekend will see the flotilla sail into Auckland Harbour. The ten ships will be visible from Waitemata Harbour and led by the much-loved Spirit of New Zealand best known for youth voyages.

The fun four days will start with the ships' arrival on Friday. Guided by Maori waka; the Harbour will become a vantage point for those wanting to view the historical boats.

On Saturday a march will have crew head to the waterfront from Wynyard Quarter. The powhiri welcoming the crew will take place at the Cloud kick-starting a festival-like atmosphere. The public will be free to hop on board and see the ships up close on Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 10am-4pm.

A full naval salute will be given as the ships depart Orakei Wharf at 1pm Monday. Venue:
