



ANZAC DAY AND CLOSING DAY REGATTA

The Regatta with the Mark Foy Starts.

Friday 25 April 2025.

Notice of Race:

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 2 & 5 and the Mullet Boat Safety Rules shall apply. Attention is drawn to the Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) Safety Regulations regulation 23 relating to classic yachts.
- 1.3 The Auckland Harbour Regulations and Auckland Council Navigation Safety Bylaws, in particular "A Moving Prohibited Zone" shall apply at all times.
- 1.4 All boats shall carry an operational VHF radio.

2.0 REGISTRATION & ENTRY:

- 2.1 Entries close at 5.00 p.m on Wednesday 23 April 2025. All entries shall include a contact email or cell phone number to enable notification of start time.
- 2.2 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Officer

Will be posted on the PCC website / Sailing and may be picked up from the registration desk at PCC from 1100 on Friday 25th April for yachts that have not received notification prior.

3. Briefing:

No briefing will be held. **Direct any queries in advance to info@pcc.org.nz**

4. SCHEDULE OF STARTS

- 4.1 Start times will be set in accordance with current handicaps and divisions including spinnaker or non-spinnaker.
- 4.2 Each boat will be allotted a start time and number. All boats will be notified of their start time and number by text or email or can download the details from the PCC Website/Sailing
- 4.3 The race will be started using the "Mark Foy" system.
- 4.4 The start line is between the flagstaff on the Westhaven Tower and the YELLOW ODM.
- 4.5 The warning signal for the first start will be a purple Flag signalled at 1225 hrs on Friday 25 April, 2025. The first start is scheduled for 1230 hrs.
- 4.6 **For Start sequences and start times refer to APPENDIX A as posted. (Refer NoR 2.3)**
 - 1. **The start numbers will be displayed on the start Tower.**
 - 2. **Boats will start when their allocated start number is removed.**
 - 3. For subsequent starts the Number Board for the next start will be displayed 1 minute before the next scheduled start.
 - 4. **Premature starters will be penalized 3 places.**

5.0 RACING AREAS

The race will be sailed on the Waitemata Harbour, Auckland.

Fairway Marks and Obstructions:

- 1. Cable beacons east of Devonport wharf – Keep South of.
- 2. Green Sandspit marker - SW of Torpedo wharf – Keep South of.

3. The yellow beacon marking the sewer line off St Mary's Bay – Keep North of.
4. Yachts shall only pass through the main navigation span of the Harbour Bridge when racing.
5. Yachts while racing shall pass on the Channel side of all moored vessels and mooring buoys.

Prohibited Areas:

6. The Westhaven mooring area defined by the line representing an extension of the permanent wave breaks.
5. The Okahu Bay wave break and all vessels and moorings in the Okahu Bay mooring Area.
6. The Defence Area marked on the Chart NZ 5322 by the Naval Dockyard
7. The Port Security & Customs area as defined by a straight line between the northern point of Wynyard Wharf and the NW point of Fergusson Wharf.

6.0 THE COURSE

The course to be sailed will be as described in Appendix B. (Refer NoR 2.3)

7.0 THE FINISH:

The finish line is between the flagstaff on the Westhaven Tower and the YELLOW ODM.
Races may be shortened.

TIME LIMIT: No finish times will be recorded after 1700 hours.

8.0 SCORING:

Placings will be recorded as the boats cross the finish line and prizes awarded accordingly.

Division Prizes may also be awarded.

Closing Day Trophies will be awarded where applicable.
