NOTICE OF RACE **Version 2**

This Notice of Race only applies to the CYANZ organised races. The organising host clubs Notice of Race shall apply for all other races. Refer to the schedule of events 4.0 for details of organising clubs.

This Notice of Race provides two separate race series. The two series include the Premier series of six (6) races and the Summer Series of twelve (12) races. Each series will be scored as two separate series.

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The Races will be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations (as below) shall apply:
 - a) Part II Category 5 shall apply to Races 1; 2; 3; 9; 11; and 12.
 - b) Part II Category 4 shall apply to races 4; 5; 6; 7; 8 and 10. It is recommended that all boats shall carry an inflated dinghy, a life raft or tow a rigid dinghy capable of carrying the entire crew as per Yachting NZ Safety Regulations.
- 1.3 Attention is drawn to regulation 23 relating to classic yachts.
- 1.4 Rules of RRS Part 2 will be altered during the races between the hours of official sunset and sunrise to give precedence to the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.
- 1.5 Should there be any conflict between the CYANZ Sailing Instructions and the CYANZ Notice of Race the Sailing instructions will prevail. This amends RRS 63.7.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The Series and individual races are open to current members of the CYANZ (with the exception of the Patio Bay Race) and whose boats meet the following CYANZ requirement criteria:
 - a) Classic Yachts designed or built prior to 31 December 1949, includes the K Class;
 - b) Modern Classic Yachts designed or built of traditional materials of the day post 1949 and prior to 31 December 1970 or who comply with the CYANZ Policy. Copy available on request or at www.classicyacht.org.nz.

3.0 Entry Fees

accepted until Wednesday 30 September 2020 at 1700.

4.2 Eleven (11) ~~Twelve (12)~~ races are scheduled for the Summer Series.

4.3 Five (5) ~~Six (6)~~ races, being races 1, 5, 6, 8, and 9 ~~and 11~~ are scheduled for the Premier Series.

4.4 The start times of each division will be advised in the Sailing Instructions.

5.0 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the CYANZ Sailing Instructions and the Sailing Instructions from the relevant organising Yacht Club which will be available online at: www.classicyacht.org.nz after 1 October 2020.

6.0 Racing Area & Courses

6.1 The races will be held in the Waitemata Harbour and Hauraki Gulf.

6.2 The courses are prescribed in the CYANZ and organizing Yacht Club Sailing Instructions.

7.0 Measurement

7.1 A boat shall comply with CYA Policy document guidelines found at www.classicyacht.org.nz.

8.0 Format

8.1 Entries will be divided into Divisions:

9.0 Scoring

9.1 The races shall be scored as per RRS Appendix A using the Low Point system.

9.2 Scoring will be provided separately for competitors entered in each of the Summer Series and Premier Series.

- 9.3 Four (4) races will be required to constitute a Summer Series.
- 9.4 Three (3) Premier nominated races will be required to constitute a Premier Series.
- 9.5 **Scoring Summer Series of 11 ~~12~~-races**
- 9.5.1 When fewer or less than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.5.2 When eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores.
- 9.5.3 When eleven (11) ~~twelve (12)~~-races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three (3) worst scores.

- 9.6 **Scoring Premier Series of ~~6~~-5 races**
The Premier Series of ~~6~~-races 5 races, competitors will exclude their one (1) worst score after four (4) races.

10.0 Prizes

- 10.1 Trophies for the Series will be presented at the CYANZ Annual Prizegiving.
- 10.2 Prizes may also be awarded at after race functions at host Yacht Clubs or on shore for CYANZ races.

11.0 Radio Communication

- 11.1 As a safety requirement all boats must maintain a listening watch on VHF Radio, on deck, at all times while racing, using the channel communicated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 11.2 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12.0 Photography Consent

- 12.1 By entering the Series competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race series and/or using the Series facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the storage, use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name(s) or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof for purposes of CYANZ publicity.

13.0 Insurance

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover to \$5,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

14.0 Disclaimer of Liability

- 14.1 All those taking part in Classic Yacht Association of New Zealand races or any other sailing or launch events controlled by the CYANZ, as between the Classic Yacht Association of NZ and each of those so taking part, do so at their own risk and responsibility and the CYANZ and any sponsor associated with this event has no liability for any damage, loss or penalty suffered by any boat, crew or any other person taking part in such races or events. The CYANZ and any sponsor of these races shall not be responsible for the sea worthiness of a boat whose entry is accepted and/or the sufficiency and/or adequacy of its equipment or the competence of its skipper or crew. The CYANZ reserves the right in its sole and uncontrolled discretion to refuse any entry.
