

Amendment 4 - CYA Sailing Instructions 2020-21

Round Rangitoto Race 8: 13 February 2021

7.4 Amended and replaced with:

Start Line: A line between Ponsonby CC Watchman (flying CYA flag) and Narrow Neck Yellow buoy.

Finish Line: A Line from Otahuhu Point (Motutapu Is) and the Vessel flying CYA flag. (14nm)

Course and Finish line: Start E to W - Rangitoto Isl (S) - Motutapu Isl (S) - Finish.

Time Limits:

Added: Any vessel not clear of 'A' buoy by 1230 is required to retire and begin steaming, without sails hoisted, to clear 'A' buoy.

Auckland Harbourmaster instruction to the CYA NZ following the NZ Govt Gazetted 36th Americas Cup declaration (www.gazette.govt.nz/notice/id/2020-go4657) is all vessels must clear 'A' buoy by 1230.

11.5 Safety Regulations and Radio Communication amended and replaced with

A boat not intending to start a scheduled race shall promptly notify the Race Control mobile: 021 487 818 or 021 818 448.

Any late entries received may be handicapped incorrectly.

Notices: Post-race


- 1. Yachties can join the Launchies after racing in Islington Bay for a BYO, where Launchies are having a BBQ.
- 2. **Post racing Prada Cup Transit lane's**, when required, can only be used with sails down.

Note (extracted from NZ Gazette): Sailing Vessels are not permitted to operate with sails hoisted, in transit lanes where event speed restrictions are in force. No stopping or reversing permitted in Transit Lanes. Must keep to starboard at all times. Lifting of 5k speed restrictions will be announced on VHF c12 and c16. **Source**: m3456 Course-Area-C-speed-restriction.pdf (americascup.com)

3. AC Course Transit requirements


Course Area D - 5 Knot Restriction
