Expression of Interest

The Classic Yacht Association (CYANZ) would be delighted to receive an 'Expression of Interest' from you and offer the following advice prior to completing the form.

- a) Owner must be a current member of the CYANZ and be reasonably competent operating his/her vessel.
- b) Vessel must qualify to be on the CYANZ Register.
- c) The vessel must have and maintain an acceptable standard of paintwork and brightwork.
- d) The age, design and providence of the vessel are important considerations. NZ built vessels are preferred but internationally constructed vessels will also be accepted if the above criteria is met.
- e) CYANZ will endeavor to provide a suitable grouping of classic vessels to best represent the heritage of New Zealand boats. The emphasis is on presenting a balanced display from all categories of vessels.

Important Information for future berth holders at the Heritage Landing

The Heritage Landing is part of the Silo Marina Westhaven and managed by Viaduct Marina Control. Health and Safety issues are primary and as such you must ensure that the behaviour of your crew and visitors comply.

There is a permanent stainless steel swim ladder mid-way along the pontoon and a portable one on the left hand side for recovery of person/s in the water. Please make yourself familiar with location and deployment. These have been used successfully in emergency situations in the past.

Be aware that the marina berths are positioned in a way that can be affected by wakes from passing water traffic accessing or exiting Westhaven Marina.

Further to this, fresh winds from a Northerly quarter can bring an uncomfortable roll to the berths and mooring lines need to be of a long nature with the ability to double-up on the North side and/or spring when these conditions are forecast. The CYANZ appointed dockmaster may recommend you consider vacating the berth in an extreme forecast situation. Mast clashing of yachts has been an issue and neighbouring yachts need to be berthed with their masts offset.
