
A Fine Record of Percy Vos and his Creations

CYA member Baden Pascoe has written a magnificent pictorial and historical record that celebrates the life of Auckland businessman and renowed boatbuilder Percy Vos, his boats and the people who worked with him.

Baden's interst in Percy Vos is fueled by the Pascoe family association to the Vos yard. Baden's father, Howard Pascoe, a very talented centreboard sailor and boatbuilder, worked for Percy in the 1940's.

Gypsy Relaunch

On Saturday 3^{rd} August more than 200 people turned out to celebrate the return of *Gypsy* to the Waitamata and welcome her to the CYA Silo Heritage landing. With the next generation of sailors gathered at his feet Sir Bob Harvey gave a heartfelt welcome and thank you to the people who rallied around to ensure *Gypsy* was restored.

John Street spoke on behalf of the Gypsy Trust which was formed to ensure her survival. John also noted that had the Percy Vos shed been available then the restoration would have been accessible for the public to follow progress rather than tucked away in sandspit.

Jill Hetherington kept the bbq flowing and visitors were welcome aboard to admire *Gypsy* in all her finery.

There are many heroes in this tale – too many to

list here – but a few deserve special mention. Colin Brown and Josh Hawke, who undertook the enormous job of reconstructing her from a very sad wreck.

Robert Brooke, with his usual generosity, has given hundreds of hours to the project. John Prior and Jill Hetherington would have been forgiven for walking away especially after Jill's terrible injuries.

However, they proved they are made of sterner stuff.

Gypsy is a significant piece of New Zealand's maritime history being the last Logan design. Designed by Arch Logan for Alan Leyland, she was built by Bill Couldry and launched in 1939. She sails under the number C46 and will be seen out racing with the Classic Yacht Association regularly.
