# Classics create great display

The 2013 CYA Classic Yacht and Launch Exhibition, again hosted by the Tino Rawa Trust, was run from 4 -6th October at Karanga Plaza and this year showcased the acclaimed designers Jack Brooke and Bob Stewart. A great selection of their yachts, launches and centreboarders was on display.

Tony Stevenson from the Tino Rawa Trust opened the exhibition and introduced Don and Robert Brooke, who both spoke about their father Jack and fellow yacht designer Bob Stewart.

In addition to the Brooke and Stewart boats on display, the recently refurbished Logan Waitangi joined the display along with 'Frances' and several classic workboats.

Two popular features of the exhibition this year were Robert Brooke's line drawing of a selection of the CYA sailing fleet and Paul Baragwanath's exquisitely restored Frostbite Corsair. The attention to detail was just amazing and she even came with her own period (1945) trailer.

Saturday was capped off with Tony putting on a keg



of Peroni beer for the boat owners and assembled CYA members. Nice boats, nice people and nice beer — it doesn't get much better than that.

If you missed the show, the Tino Rawa Trust has produced wonderful а booklet, The Jack Brooke Story - A Celebration Of A New Zealand Amateur Yacht Designer, written by Harold Kidd with illustrations and photos from Robert Brooke, that records the work and life of Jack Brooke.
