Destination Mahurangi Harbour 22.5 miles

Course

- Start at Devonport in an easterly direction
- Whangaparaoa Passage Navy yellow buoy (Fl.Y 3 sec) Port,
- Finish in a westerly direction between the finish boat and Sadler Point at the Northern entrance to Mahurangi Harbour

Special Notices

Safety: Attention is drawn to the General Sailing Instructions regarding safety provisions. All skippers are encouraged to take their own finish times even if there a finish boat on station. They should also note the details of the yacht finishing in front & behind them if possible.

Lifejackets: It is recommended that competitors wear a life jacket and approved safety harness after sunset.

Starting of All Divisions:

The start line will be a line between the Flagstaff at the DYC and “Torpedo” yellow buoy but limited inshore by the outer line of all moored vessels and moorings between Torpedo Bay and Devonport wharves. As per Section 11.2 in the DYC Sailing Instructions

Finishing of All Divisions:

The finish boat will show distinctive bluish flashing light vertically disposed and may be on station until 0200hrs Saturday 30th January. Boats finishing should endeavour to pass close to the finish boat, leaving the finish boat to Port and illuminate sail numbers.

Boats expecting to finish after 0200hrs are to call on VHF Channel 62, before 0200hrs, to advise their position. Boats finishing after 0200hrs are to take their own finishing times and advise the Sailing Committee by 1000hrs Saturday 30th.

All skippers are encouraged to take their own finish times even if there a finish boat on station. They should also note the details of the yacht finishing in front & behind them if possible.

Classic Yachts :

- Finish Times: Must be advised or texted to Joyce: 021 818 448 no later than 1100hrs on Saturday 29th January 2021 or boat will be scored as DNF
- The carrying of extras or dinghies will be in accordance with the CYA General Sailing Instructions & Notice to Race.

Mullet Boats:

The carrying of extras or dinghies will be in accordance with the Mullet Boat Association General Sailing Instructions & Notice to Race.

Postponement: In the event of inclement weather the sailing committee may re-schedule the race to Saturday 30th January. A Division, Classic A and Modern Classics will start at 1000hrs and B Division Woollacott, and Classic B at 1005hrs. Postponement will be recorded on the Club answer phone by 1200hrs Friday 28th.
