

**Destination:** Mahurangi Harbour    22.5 miles

#### Course

- Start at Devonport in an easterly direction
- Whangaparaoa Passage Navy yellow buoy (FL.Y 3s) Port
- **Finish in a northerly direction between Te Haupa Island and Pudding Island. There will be no finish boat so please take your own time when passing west of the beacon on the southern point of Te Haupa Island and when this beacon has a bearing of 090deg T and is transit with the southernmost point of Motuora Island – see figure below.**

## Special Notices

**Safety:** Attention is drawn to the General Sailing Instructions regarding safety provisions.

**Lifejackets:** It is recommended that competitors wear a life jacket and approved safety harness after sunset.

**Finishing of All Divisions:** all skippers shall take their own finish times to the nearest second and corrected to NZ Daylight Time, e.g. use a mobile phone, GPS device or calibrated timepiece. Skippers should also note the details of the yachts finishing in front and behind them if possible. Finish times for yachts racing in DYC A & B Divisions shall be advised to the Officer of the Day, Grant Daniel, 021 778 205, by 1100 hrs, Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2026.

### Classic Yachts:

Finish Times: Must be advised or texted to Joyce: 021 818 448 no later than 1100hrs on Saturday 24th January 2026 or boat will be scored as DNF.

The carrying of extras or dinghies will be in accordance with the CYA General Sailing Instructions & Notice to Race.

**Postponement:** In the event of inclement weather, the sailing committee may reschedule the race to Saturday 24th January 2026. Such a postponement will be advised by email to race entrants and posted on the club website by 1200hrs Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2026. In this case:

- A Division start 1000hrs
- Classic A and Modern Classics start 1005hrs
- Classic B start 1010hrs
- B Division start 1015hrs

**Time Limit:** There is no time limit.
