By popular request, Frank Warnock is coming back to the CYANZ to speak on sails and sailmaking. Frank began his sail making apprenticeship in 1949 with Sails & Covers and during a 10,000 hour apprenticeship over six years Frank worked on many of the Division One sails, including those of 'Rainbow'. In 1955 Frank founded Shore Sails and eventually opened lofts in Westhaven and Gulf Harbour.

During his 42 year career Frank has made over 35,000 sails and amassed a huge depth of knowledge of sailcloth and traditional sail making that should be of great interest to any classic yacht owner.

Frank's talk in 2007 was one of the 'gems' of the CYA's members nights and April's social night is a 'not to be missed' occasion! He is a wonderful raconteur with many stories of the characters involved with Auckland yachting from the 1940's and onwards
