Rudder Cup Centennial Race 12 December 2008

An historic race from Auckland, round Sail Rock and back to Auckland (108nm) for classic launches will take place on Friday 12 December 2008 – exactly 100 years since the race was run originally.

The CYANZ is now taking registrations of interest from interested participants – more information and registration of interest forms are available online: www.classicyacht.org.nz or by contacting Joyce: 09 836-4747

It is hoped that two of the original boats will take part, including *Seabird* from Nelson, who took line honours in 1908.

We anticipate there will be around 30 entries spread across four divisions:

Veteran – launched before 31/12/1918

Vintage – launched between 1/1/1919 and 31/12/1949

Classic - launched between 1/1/1950 and 31/12/1978

Spirit of Tradition – built since 1/1/1979 to a design dated back to before 1950

The race will start at 1900hrs on Friday 12th December 2008 with the first finishers expected at around 0500hrs on Saturday 13th December, with prize giving on Saturday evening.

This will be a handicap event, with sealed handicaps as per the original race. It is hoped to have the competing vessels moored together (venue to be confirmed) from Wednesday 10 December, until Sunday 14 December

IMPORTANT: Points to note

- 1. The race will be run under the supervision of the Classic Yacht Association of NZ (CYANZ) and to safety regulations based on Yachting NZ's Safety Category 3 with amendments.
- Owners and/or Skippers will be required to be financial members of CYANZ.
- 3. CYANZ Launch numbers will be required to be worn.
- 4. Launches must have a minimum length on deck of 30 ft.

This is a closed event and skippers whose launches meet the safety and requirements of the Rudder Cup Race Committee will be invited to enter.

So if you're vessel is 30ft or longer and you're keen to take part in this historic event....REGISTER NOW!!
