## Amnesty from Yachting New Zealand

Is your yacht registered? If not, change of ownership registration is free until the end of January 2010.

It is important to register e.g. in an emergency or if your boat is stolen, registration will help enable rapid tracing of your boat by rescuers or police.

Registration is also a compulsory aspect of racing, because registration ensures compliance with RRS76.1 in the Yachting New Zealand Racing Rules & Safety Regulations.

You only need to register your boat once, and registration is permanent until somebody else takes ownership of it.
