In March 2025 Richard Marks spied a 1904 Logan in the Whangaroa Harbour for sale and was immediately taken by her. She had been owned by Henry Roberts for an incredible 46 years.

When Richard pondered the

purchase, and while going through her documented provenance, behold a wonderful surprise for him to discover his grandfather had owned QUEENIE between 1950-1952.

She'd been moored in the Whangaroa harbour for the previous 15 years and had the appearance of being cared for. However, Richard sought out our renowned member and restoration specialist, Peter Brookes, to look her over. Peter gave her bones a clean bill. The decision was made! She was soon brought to Peter's yard in Auckland for a makeover.


A June 1963 Farmers Trading Company magazine stated that Bill Travis, supervisor of the Farmers furniture department, owned QUEENIE and that she sailed in the C Class.

Richard has decided to refurbish her back to the "K Class" status she'd been converted to many years ago. Although she was originally gaff-rigged, could anyone begrudge a lady for having a few enhancements at 121 years old?

Another surprise came when Richard went to register her under his name. He discovered her sail number was now 201, not the C1 sail number given to her in 1939. C1 had been given to the famous New Zealand Bruce Farr Ocean racing yacht, ENDEAVOUR.

Richard was quick to communicate with Yachting NZ. With a bit of negotiation, he was able to have QUEENIE's C1 status reinstated.

Richard plans to have his 121 -year-old beauty ready to join the Auckland fleet in the 2025/6 summer series, sailing with her C1 sails snapping in the breeze.
