



Pacific Storm Rescue

The Classic Yacht Association are privileged to have Larry Robbins recount his experiences while in command of HMNZS Monowai, in what was to become the largest maritime search and rescue ever conducted from New Zealand.

A fleet of Yachts cruising towards Tonga at the start of the season became embroiled in a large depression (weather bomb) in which 21 people were rescued from seven yachts. This search and rescue mission involved the help from not only Monowai, but also a fishing vessel, three merchant ships and a French Navy ship.

Due to the superb efforts in this mission, the Monowai crew received a number of awards and Larry was awarded the OBE.
