WINTER is here and if you're not planning to do too much boating, it may well be a great opportunity to get some maintenance done on the boat, and/or to hone your boating knowledge.

Boating Maintenance:

• Check the integrity of your paint work. If paint is cracking or flaking, then the protective coating over your timber is compromised, allowing water to penetrate and potentially cause rot.

Check that all deck fittings are firmly secured with no movement. Loose fittings could indicate that seals between surfaces and fastenings have broken or have had water penetration causing disintegration of timber.
Check window seals: a common area where water will sit and potentially cause problems.

• Check your anchor warp for wear, and all spliced joins, D shackles, chain and anchor for corrosion.

• Check sheets, rigging, sails. If you're keen to ensure that you don't have gear failure on a race, now would be the time to give everything a top to toe look and repair or replace.

• For those of you with engines, an annual service would be apt; oils, timing, seals, hoses, bugs and coolant to name a few.

• Below the water line; check out what is happening down under: condition of anodes, antifouling, all through hull fittings.

• For those of you who love to cruise and have a few embellishments like

fridges/freezers, it'd be a great time to have your system serviced, there's nothing worse than a warm drink on a hot day.

• Safety check: Fire extinguishers, Flares, life jackets, VHF & bilge pump float switch.

• If I've missed anything, my apologies.

Compulsory wearing of personal floatation devices is currently under discussion in our region.

Waikato Regional Council already enforces having a correctly sized PFD for each person on board. In vessels less than 6m, everyone must wear a lifejacket unless the skipper considers that it is safe not to.

Waikato Regional Council also state that PFD's must be worn if there are high risks to people's safety.

The Safety of the Captain and Crew of Vessels is imperative. The CYA recommends that lifejackets are worn whilst cruising and racing especially when the weather is not ideal and/or there is a lot of other boat traffic about.
