Plans are underway for the next season's racing and events, of which much was discussed at the Boat Owners meeting held last week. A summary of points covered are below:

Boat Owners Meeting Highlights Vos Shed Update

Frith Walker, Waterfront Auckland, advised project awaiting funding approval (June 18th). Members were advised that the building was available on request for short-term projects.

Season Debrief

While actual race entries were low (weather, lack of time & available crews) the majority of skippers enjoyed the quick fire race format but expressed dissatisfaction with the Mark Foy starts in the passage series. Mark Foy is used due to difficulties in sourcing start/finishes boats & race management volunteers.
Concerns raised on Anniversary Regatta course length & inner barbour speed

Concerns raised on Anniversary Regatta course length & inner harbour speed restrictions. Feedback will be passed on to regatta committee.

It was agreed that excluding Patio Bay, the CYA will not host races & revert back to partnering with selected yacht clubs.

Consideration is to be given to having alternative courses set if weather is not suitable for classic racing, thereby avoiding total race cancellations.

Consideration is being given to moving the hosting of the Classic Yacht Regatta to an established venue i.e. yacht club.

Membership

Numbers remain static (300) despite strong new membership applications. Good discussion on engaging all members to participate in events to hopefully arrest the retention issue.
