Depending on the weather forecast, we'll pick a destination for a great Easter Cruise. All updates will be coming on the website, otherwise contact Tanya for further information.

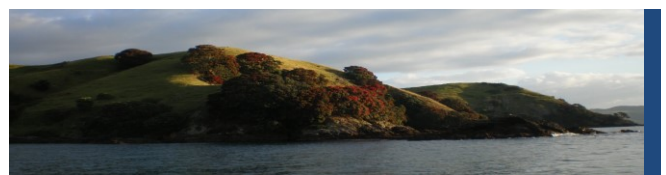


30th April 2016

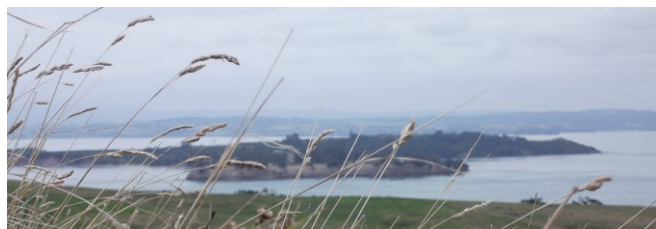
