A PIECE OF SAILING HISTORY LOOKING FOR A NEW HOME





YVONNE (see our lead photo) is one of the earliest and most famous yachts of the Logan fleet and is berthed in Lyttleton, where she has spent most of her life.

In 1893 Arch Buchanan engaged Robert Logan to construct her for both racing and cruising. Dimensions: LOA 43'6, LWL 30'.6, Beam 8'6. Rig: Gaff Cutter

In 1894 she won the New Zealand Championship race at the Anniversary Day Regatta as a 5 Rater, an event which in those days was attended by people from all around NZ. It was the place to be seen before A & P shows arrived.

Master of wooden craft, Chris Morrison, has gone fully over YVONNE, replacing any faulty timbers and doing other maintenance.

She has sailed and raced extensively around the South Island and comes with a ship's log showing many of her journeys. In the hands of H. Norris, she won the first keeler class series of the Banks Peninsula Cruising Club.

In early years she did battle with the Titans: IORANGI, PASTIME, RAINBOW & WAITANGI.

Sadly, it's now time to let her go to a new loving home. If you're keen for a piece of maritime history, <u>check her out.</u>
