Guest Speaker: Frank Warnock

November's CYA social night will feature Club member Frank Warnock, who will be speaking on sails and sailmaking. Frank began his sailmaking apprenticeship in 1949 with Sails & Covers. During a 10,000 hour apprenticeship over six years, Frank worked on many of the Division One yacht sails, including those of Rainbow. In 1955 Frank founded Shore Sails, and eventually opened lofts in Gulf Harbour and Westhaven. During his 42 year career Frank has made over 35,000 sails, and has amassed a huge depth of knowledge of sailcloth and traditional sailmaking that should be of great interest to any classic yacht owner.
