Classics have the option of racing back from Mahurangi on Sunday, and berthing in the Viaduct Harbour for a fun evening before taking part in Monday's festivities.

Winners not only receive cash prizes, but the opportunity to have their name engraved forever on a famous sailing trophy - the silverware, which is on permanent display at the Maritime Museum, is worth over \$80,000.

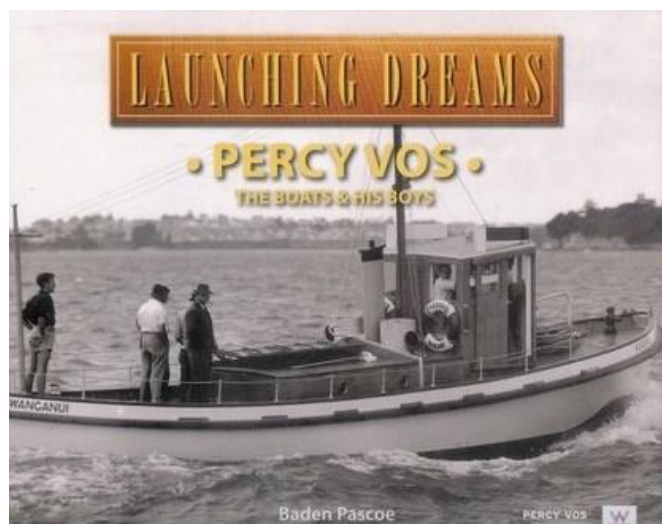
