My earliest recollections of Bill sailing was on Iorangi in the Bay of Islands Christmas Cruise of 1968. Shortly thereafter, he joined the crew of Prize racing with us until the mid-1970s when Prize went cruising and we both joined the racing crew of Milton Mabee's 34' Townson, "Barcarole".

Bill was always a person who thought long and hard about decisions of importance, and yet when he came to me in 1978 and suggested we should buy a Soling (a 28' Olympic Class keeler), you would have to say it was a rush of blood to the head. The Soling's were nothing like anything we had sailed before, presenting us a learning curve steeper than anything we had experienced in sailing. It set us both up to be competitive sailors forever.

Sailing then took on the Corinthian spirit and in the 1990s when Bill bought into the syndicate that owned the C class *Janet* which his wife Mary, Mike Austin, John Montgomery and Steve Corbett owned. The day-sailing which they enjoyed on her, soon led to Bill and Mary buying the beautiful Davidson 35, *Simplicity*, which they owned until Bill's illness forced them to sell 3 years ago. Many cruises with family and friends saw them sailing extensively throughout the Hauraki Gulf and racing with the Devonport Yacht Club, where he was treasurer for a number of years.

His passing is a great loss to a very extensive group of friends.

With the racing season upon us, it is important that you get your race entries in. With the new website, entering races has been made a lot easier. Simply follow the steps, once you've gone onto the Sailing Tab.

You can either choose an **Online Entry** (credit card required):

- Select the Series and/or individual races you would like to do.
- Fill out the entry form at the bottom of the page, and submit
- Add to cart: This will calculate the sum of the races entered and you will be required to enter your credit card details here.

Please remember that Race Entries are required to be in by the Wednesday before the race.
