### Lexia – 1904 8.5 m Bailey Keeler

'The 1904, Bailey (Jnr) built 8 metre gaff staysail sloop LEXIA is for sale due to owner's declining health. The boat is of carvel construction on bent frames. She is in good condition. She is fitted with a galley containing a sink and gas stove, a chemical toilet, VHF radio approx. 5 years old, echo sounder approx. 4 years old, and a 2 cylinder fresh water cooled Yanmar engine. The electrical circuit is split- house and starting with two batteries. She will sleep two persons comfortably. The keel bolts were replaced 2003. The spars are of Oregon pine and kauri, varnished. The sails are in good condition with a spare main sail. Standing rigging is of stainless steel wire. Bailey's were in competition to the Logan Brothers, who, without such competition, could not have become the premier boat builders of the time. LEXIA is the 7th oldest boat in the Auckland Classic Yacht fleet, and should be preserved for future generations.'
