Day 2: Gusty winds of up to 28 knots limited racing to one event. Kiwi sailors joined CYAA skippers on various vessels, enjoying the post-race hospitality at RYCV. This year's crop of Kiwi sailors were repeat visitors lain Valentine, Larry Paul, Martin Robertson. They were joined by a bunch of first-time Melbourne CYAA visitors: Barry Besley, Frances Billot, Peter Brookes, Michael O'Dwyer, James Waters and Don Robertson.
