SSI 1

Division	Fleet/Class	Number of Races	Warning Signal	Class Flag
Classics	Classic Yacht Assn	1	1250	CYA Burgee
*Open	Open all	1	1255	RNZYS Burgee

*Open division includes all other boats that are not CYA. Open boats can race spinnaker or non-spinnaker but must state this in the race entry. To be clear: all Open boats are in the same division however non spinnaker boats may be given a more favourable start time.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 3 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left will be announced on Friday by 1900 hrs in a Notice to Competitors emailed out to entrants, and posted on the official noticeboard in the main foyer of RNZYS and available at Reception.

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 4 The race will be started by using RRS 26. The race will be run under the Mark Foy 'pursuit race' starting system, except the CYA division which will start at 1255hrs.

SSI 5 The starting signals will be:

1250hrs	Warning Signal	CYA Burgee Up
1251hrs	Preparatory Signal	Code Flag "P" Up
1254hrs	Preparatory Signal	Code Flag "P" Down
1255hrs	CYA Start & RNZYS Warning Signal	CYA Burgee Down RNZYS Burgee Up
1256hrs	Preparatory Signal	Code Flag "P" Up
1259hrs	Preparatory Signal	Code Flag "P" Down
1300hrs	RNZYS Mark Foy Sequence Start	RNZYS Burgee Down
	Boats will start when that boat's allocated number is removed	
1301hrs	Etc.	

SSI 6 Mark Foy race: The attention of competitors will be drawn to the four (4) warning signals in the start sequence by a sound signal. No sound signals will be made after the first boat has started.

SSI 7 A yacht starting before their scheduled start time will have 3 points added to their score, there will be no recalls, this changes RRS29

SSI 8 The start schedule with start times for each yacht will be published on the RNZYS website and emailed to all entries on Friday 2nd October before 1700hrs. This will also be available from RNZYS Reception.

SSI 9 The starting line will be between the flagstaff on the Westhaven tower and the yellow Westhaven Buoy.



TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

SSI 10

Fleet/Class	Time Limit for first finisher	Extension if one boat finishes within time limit
All divisions	120 minutes	30 mins

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

PENALTY SYSTEM (SI 14)

SSI 11 The Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
